Purpose	This Program Memo (PM) provides funding information and specifies reporting requirements for your October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017, Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2017 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program – Education (SNAP-Ed) Contract SP16-17, Amendment #1. All contract-related documents, including Budget Displays and the Local Assistance Contract Checklist (CDA 9007), can be found on the Aging Area Agencies on Aging (AAA) page of the California Department of Aging's (CDA) website.	
Funding	CDA is amending the contract to reflect the allocation of \$47,226 of unspent federal funds identified in the closeout process to be carried in from FFY 2016. The unspent funds were relocated to all AAAs participating in the SNAP-Ed program.
