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## Managed Care Transition Plan for the Community-Based Adult Services Program (CBAS)

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is pleased to announce our plan for transitioning Community Based Adult Services (CBAS) into managed care. The Darling v. Douglas Settlement Agreement required that this migration occur no earlier than July 1, 2012. Our transition plan is a two phased plan that starts the transition with 12 County Organized Health System (COHS) plans in July. This first phase represents a conservative initial transition of less than 10% of our current CBAS participants, 31 of our CBAS providers, and 5 individual plan partner organizations serving 12 counties. The COHS plans have all of their CBAS participants enrolled in their respective plans, which will be helpful to a smooth transition of CBAS services under each plan starting in July.

The second phase will transition the remaining managed care plans on October 1<sup>st</sup>. This second phase represents the transition of the remaining CBAS participants, 222 CBAS providers, and 16 individual plan partner organizations serving 17 counties.

The period between now and October provides ample time for enrollment processes to run their course so participants are smoothly transitioned into managed care. This period before October 1<sup>st</sup> also allows Phase 2 plans and providers to complete their contractual agreements before the start of the delivery of CBAS services under managed care.

With this phased approach, DHCS can also learn from the Phase 1 transition to make the Phase 2 transition that much smoother.

The table below reflects the individual plans and counties in each phase of this historic transition.
