This Program Memo (PM) transmits the Title V/Senior Community Service Employment Program Planning Estimate (PE) for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2007-08. Federal funds included in this PE are based on the prior year federal allocation from the Department of Labor. State funds are based on the prior year State allocation and include an additional \$.50 per hour augmentation to offset the minimum wage increase to \$8.00 per hour, effective January 1, 2008. Allocated participant slots were used to distribute federal and State funds to each Area Agency on Aging.

The Department anticipates issuing a contract based on this PE by April 1, 2007. The PM that transmits the contract and Budget Display will provide instructions on the specific date for submitting a budget that reflects the figures included in the Budget Display.
