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MANAGER WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF AGING AND I'M VERY HONORED TO GO AHEAD.

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ON MY VIEW, PEOPLE AND HONOR THEIR RESILIENCE AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION.

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THANK YOU, AND AS I SAID, I'M VERY EXCITED TO BRING HER ON BOARD.

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SHE COMES WITH THE BREADTH OF KNOWLEDGE, AND JUST HAS A DEEP CONNECTIONS WITH TRIBAL COMMUNITIES, AND SO MORE TO COME.

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SIGN A PROCLAMATION, 8, 80, 83, 69.

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THAT CHANGED THE NAME FROM ASIAN PACIFIC AMERICAN HERITAGE.

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MONTH TO AAPI HERITAGE MONTH, RECOGNIZING MANY CONTRIBUTIONS.

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AND INFLUENCE OF ASIAN AMERICANS AND PACIFIC ISLANDERS.

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AMERICANS TO THE HISTORY, CULTURE, AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE US. SO, ONE MAY WONDER WHY WE USE THE MONTH OF MAY TO CELEBRATE THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF API, AND THERE ARE 2 REASONS.

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SO, IF WE LOOK BACK IN HISTORY ABOUT A HUNDRED, 80 YEARS AGO, ON MAY SEVENTH, 1843, 14 YEAR OLD, FISHERMAN NAMED NAKAAMA MADIRO, BECAME THE FIRST OFFICIAL U. S.

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JAPANESE IMMIGRANT, AFTER BEING ADOPTED BY AMERICAN CAPTAIN WILLIAM WITCHFIELD, WHO RESCUE HIM AND HIS CREW.

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AFTER A SHIPWRECK 300 MILES AWAY FROM THE COAST OF JAPAN, AND THEN, 26 YEARS LATER, IN 1869 SPECIFICALLY MAY TENTH, 1869, COMMEMORATED THE COMPLETION OF THE BUILDING OF THE TRANSCONTINENTAL RAILROAD WHICH WAS DONE BY A LOT OF SWEAT EQUITY

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SO THAT WE CAN WALK THROUGH SOME OF THE IMPORTANT EVENTS.

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SO, IN ADDITION TO THE 2 LANDMARK EVENTS I JUST DESCRIBED TO YOU IN 1,854, THE CALIFORNIA SUPREME COURT, REINFORCE THE RACISM AGAINST ASIAN IMMIGRANTS IN THE PEOPLE VERSUS WHOLE RULING THAT'S PEOPLE OF ASIAN DESCENT COULD NOT TESTIFY AGAINST A WHITE PERSON IN

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AND THEN, IN 1882, WHICH WAS A 7 YEARS LATER, THERE WAS THE CHINESE EXCLUSION ACT, BANNING CHINESE IMMIGRATION.

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3 YEARS AFTER WE WITNESSED THE MASSACRE OF 28 CHINESE MINORS AND BURNING OF A 79 HOMES IN A CHINATOWN AREA OF ROCK SPRINGS, WYOMING, AND BECAUSE THE WHITE MINUS WE'RE ANGRY.

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THAT'S CHINESE MINERS TO AWAY THEIR JOBS. AND THEN, 2 YEARS LATER, IN A YEAR 1887, THERE WAS ANOTHER MASSACRE OF 34 CHINESE, MINUS A LONG SNAKE RIVER IN OREGON.

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FOR THE SAME REASON, AND IF, 30 YEARS LATER, ON 1917, THE IMMIGRATION ACT OF BANNING CHINESE, ASIAN INDIANS, BURMESE, THAI, AND MALAYS AS PART OF THE ASIATIC BAR, SOON MANY OF US REMEMBER DECEMBER SEVENTH, 1941, THE BOMBING OF PEARL
