

**Aged/Elder Population  
Proposed Vaccination Approach  
January 2021**

The following proposed approaches are based on client needs and existing best practices. However, these proposals do not take into consideration resources and staffing needed to support these proposed approaches.

These proposals prioritize efforts to reach those who are most vulnerable, low income, aged, people of color in our county starting with HSA and AAA clients to ensure equitable access.

Criteria used to identify groups reflects eligibility criteria established by the federally funded *Home Delivered Meals Program* program (pre-COVID) and *IHSS* criteria for those clients categorized as, “severely impaired” which mirror the home delivered meals eligibility criteria.

County Outreach and Marketing will need to be expanded to provide specific information targeted to this population (age friendly) with unique information regarding specialized services (example- Homebound clients can receive home visit mobile vaccinations) with a list of criteria to screen clients in/out, with a requirement of proof that must be provided by the client in order to receive these services. Providing video links for this population to view and hear instructions will ensure comprehension of these detailed instructions.
