## **Recent CDPH Guidance for ADHCs**



- Recent guidance issued by CDPH to address the current state of the pandemic:
  - <u>State Public Health Officer Order of December 22, 2021 "Health Care Worker Vaccine Requirement" (Issued 12/22/21)</u>
    - <u>Related Materials: Health Care Worker Vaccine Requirement Q&A (Issued 12/24/21)</u> Note: The "Related Materials Q&A" addresses frequently asked questions and is continuously updated.
  - AFL 21-29.1 Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Testing, Vaccination Verification and Personal Protective Equipment for Health Care Personnel (HC) at Health Care Facilities (Issued 12/27/21)

The date when CBAS TAS flexibilities and CDPH ADHC licensing flexibilities will end is not yet determined, but an early 2022 date is anticipated.

- CDA is working with our state partners to confirm an end date.
- CDA will release guidance regarding timelines and requirements for transitioning from remote to full in-center services when more public health guidance specific to ADHC licensing flexibilities is released and when the end date for CBAS TAS is determined.

## **Existing Flexibilities in CBAS ACLs**



### **Current focus:**

- Ensuring that services provided under CBAS TAS meet requirements and continue to address participants' needs
- Planning and preparing for the full return to CBAS program requirements when it is safe to do so according to state and local public health guidance

**Meanwhile**, all requirements specified in the following ACLs continue to apply:

- ✓ <u>ACL 21-04 Transition to Congregate Center Services</u> apply e.g., full MDTs, assessments and evaluations, IPCs, . . .
- ✓ <u>ACL 21-10 Postponement of Deadline for CBAS Transition of All Participants to In-Center</u> <u>Services and Other Planning Updates</u>
- ✓ ACL 21-13 CBAS Temporary Alternative Services (TAS): Remote Services Standards and Documentation Requirements

## 1115 "CalAIM" Waiver Approval



- The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has approved the Medi-Cal 2020 Section 1115 Demonstration, now entitled the "California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal (CalAIM)" initiative, with an effective date of January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2026.
  - Refer to the <u>CMS Approval Letter and Special Terms and Conditions (STCs) and</u> <u>Standards of Participation (SOPs)</u>.
  - Refer to the <u>DHCS CalAIM 1115 Demonstration & 1915(b) Waiver</u> and <u>DHCS</u> <u>CalAIM</u> webpages for additional information.
- The 1115 "CalAIM" Waiver includes the provision of CBAS Emergency Remote Services (ERS) under specified emergency conditions. <u>Note</u>: CBAS TAS and CBAS ERS are distinctive services.
- Refer to the CBAS STCs (beginning on page 16) and SOPs (beginning on page 127) in the <u>CMS Approval Letter</u>.

CBAS providers may vary in their approach to addressing the needs of their participants during the current state of the pandemic, while following current local and state public health guidance and CDA policy directives on existing flexibilities.

 N-17-21 (10/4/21) - Extends specified ADHC flexibilities through 12/31/21
 N-21-21 (11/10/21) - Extends State of Emergency & specified flexibilities through 3/31/22.
