New stakeholder committee members will be named in 2021 to join the **Implementing Master Plan for Aging in California Together (IMPACT) Committee** to advise on the administration and implementation of the MPA. New advisory committees will also be created to address **Long Term Services and Supports for Aging and Disability, Equity in Aging**, and **Elder Abuse and Justice**.
