W00-W15, W160-W164, W17-W19 **AND** it was the initial encounter

ED Emergency Department Treat and Release

IP Seen in the Emergency Department and then admitted for inpatient care

Notes

Data for 2015 are reported in 9-month and 3-month timeframes. For the first 9 months (January – September), ICD-9-CM were used for diagnoses and procedures. For the last 3 months (October – December), ICD-10-CM codes were used. There is not a direct crosswalk of ICD-9-CM codes to ICD-10-CM codes, and the data should not be combined. Comparisons across years should be made with caution. The data are reported separately in this table.

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
